She graduated Physics at the University of Bucharest in 1987. Since 2001 she holds a PhD in Physics of the Solid State.

Between 1987 and 1998 she taught Physics in lower and upper secondary schools. Since 1998 she teaches Physics (Physics of the Solid State, General Physics, Electricity and Magnetism) at the University of Piteşti. Since 2005 she teaches also Institutions of the European Union, Projects Management, Team Work, Theories of International Relations (she obtained a PhD in Political Sciences/International Relations in 2011).

Georgeta Chirleşan is an expert in designing and implementing European projects focusing on the areas of education, training, culture, sciences.

So far she has been involved as coordinator or team member in more than 70 projects funded by the European Commission (TEMPUS, PHARE, LLP – all sectoral programmes and Key actions, Jean Monnet, Youth in Action, European Social Fund - Romania) or in research projects funded by the Romanian state.
