

Filip Moens is a lecturer/instructor at University College Arteveldehogeschool.

He completed his Master's degree in Germanic Languages at University of Antwerp in 1997 and took a teacher's certificate at the same University in 1998 (cum laude). Since then he has kept on studying; he took two postgraduate degrees (Dutch-to-non-native course at the University of Antwerp in 2007 and Diversity Management at the University of Louvain in 2009). Some shorter in-service trainings include Intercultural Education (University College Arteveldehogeschool in Ghent, 2005) and Group Dynamics in the Classroom (Comenius course in Cyprus, 2003).

Filip Moens is currently a member of the English section in the Bachelor in Education: Secondary Education Department at University College Arteveldehogeschool. He teaches future lower secondary school English teachers, is involved in the guidance and coaching of student teachers and works on course development. From 2007 till 2012 he was Head of this English Department.

Further, Filip Moens has been involved in the international workings of the teacher training department for 8 years. First as an international agent, taking care of the international contacts of the department and coaching students who spend time abroad as part of their teaching practice. Since 4 years he has been co-working with the pedagogical department in a course to prepare students for studying abroad (eg. Erasmus).

He was coordinator of SWWAN, a Grundtvig course on using video to promote intercultural understanding with partners from Finland, Spain, Germany and Norway. He was also assistant in a Comenius course on Motivating and mentoring the beginning teacher in Malta.
