She graduated in the English Language philology from the University of Vilnius in 1985 and she has been teaching at Vilnius University since 1989. In 2004-2008 she was a doctoral student at Klaipėda University and in 2009 was awarded a doctor's degree in Social Sciences (Education) (07 S).

Her professional interests include foreign language didactics, foreign language teaching theories; personality development in teaching/ learning process at universities; the development of future foreign language teachers' value attitudes; the development of teachers' competences (intercultural, general, linguistic, pedagogical); social responsibility, intercultural communication.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Roma Kriauciūnienė investigates foreign language teachers' viewpoints on the development of learners' intercultural competence in the process of foreign language teaching/learning. She is also interested in researching into educational prerequisites of the development of students' value attitudes and integration of values into study programmes of contemporary universities as well as the investigation of foreign language teachers' approach to instrumental and terminal values and their approach to the development of values in the lessons of the English language.
