Dr Michael Davies is a Senior Lecturer in the School of Education and Professional Studies, Program Leader in Special Education, and Convenor of the Bachelor of Education - Special Education at Griffith University.

He is a registered psychologist with a Bachelor of Economics, Graduate Diploma in Psychology, a Master of Applied Psychology from University of Queensland, and a PhD from Griffith University.

Dr Davies has established a strong research profile within interconnecting research themes of transitions, social skills, stress and coping, and inclusive practices. His lifetime summary of research includes almost 60 publications. He has published nine refereed journal articles, eight book chapters (four as sole author and two in international handbooks), along with more than 20 refereed conference publications.

His work has been presented to academic and practitioner communities through 31 conference presentations at 21 academic conferences (10 at five overseas conferences; and 21 at 16 Australian conferences). Dr Davies is often invited as a keynote speaker or expert to present his research at National and International Conferences.

He has had success with three competitive external research grants with funding totalling \$460,000, and eight competitive internal grants totalling \$62,700. He currently conducts collaborative research with international partners at Rutgers University, New Jersey, and Arizona State University, and a number of Australian educational authorities.

Dr Davies is also an Associate Editor for the International Journal of Disability, Development and Education.
