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Matteo Perchiazzi is the creator, founder and director of the Italian School Mentoring (SIM).

He graduated in Political Science at University of Florence in Methodology of Social Sciences in 1999 and since 2000 has embarked on a path of research, consultancy, training in national and international projects, with Italian and European partnership. Since 2000, he participated in several projects funded by European Programs and public and private clients as consultant for human resources development, with particular attention on mentoring, expert in training methodologies in integrated actions / projects.

In 2010, he got his PHD - in Psychology of Work and Human Resources at the University of Rome Lumsa - Faculty of Education with a research thesis on mentoring in the workplace.

Just following that path, in 2010 Matteo Perchiazzi founded Scuola Italiana di Mentoring. The activities of the school are based on four main areas: consulting, research, training and certification of certified bodies SIM, with the aim to aggregate in communities of practice and professional bodies around the methodology of Mentoring.
