Ronald J. Glossop is Professor Emeritus at Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville (SIUE).

His Ph.D. is from Washington University in Saint Louis (1960). From 1965 to 2000 he taught at SIUE. He is author of three books, Philosophy: an Introduction to its Problems and Vocabulary (Dell, 1974), Confronting War (McFarland, 1983, 1987, 1994, 4th ed. 2001) and World Federation? (McFarland, 1994). The translation of this last book into Esperanto by Johano Rapley titled Monda Federacio was self-published in 2001.

Ronald Glossop has also authored more than 70 articles in professional journals as well as giving lectures sometimes in English and sometimes in Esperanto about the philosophy of David Hume, about the problem of war and other urgent global problems, and about the teaching of Esperanto. These presentations have been in various states of the United States of America plus 15 foreign countries (Austria, Brazil, China, Croatia, Denmark, England, France, Hungary, Italy, Lithunia, the Netherlands, Rumania, Russia, South Korea, and Sweden).

Professor Glossop is President of the American Association of Instructors of Esperanto, Director of Infanoj chirkau la Mondo [Children around the World], past Vice-President of the World Federalist Association-U.S.A., Chair of Citizens for Global Solutions of Saint Louis, and a member of the Board of Officers and Directors of the United Nations Association of Saint Louis.

Dr. Glossop is an Honorary Member of Esperanto-USA and an Honorary Member of Rotary International. He is in the Pantheon of outstanding instructors of Esperanto at edukado.net, and he is a member of two academic honor societies, Phi Beta Kappa and Phi Beta Phi.
