Prof. Carlo Nofri is the Director of the Training&Research Language Centre *Tutors in Rome* ([www.tutorsinrome.it](http://www.tutorsinrome.it)) and the chief editor of the linguistic review *Culturiana* ([www.culturiana.it](http://www.culturiana.it)). He holds a university degree in Philosophy of language and has been teaching Language Pedagogy at the CLICI centre for foreigners of the University of Rome Tor Vergata. He is the author of several articles and publications on the teaching of modern languages and has focused his research in particular on the relationship between language and thought (see *Language and Mental Imagery*, 1991, Introduction by Tullio De Mauro) and on the humanistic approach to language teaching (*Guide to Glottodrama method*, 2010).
