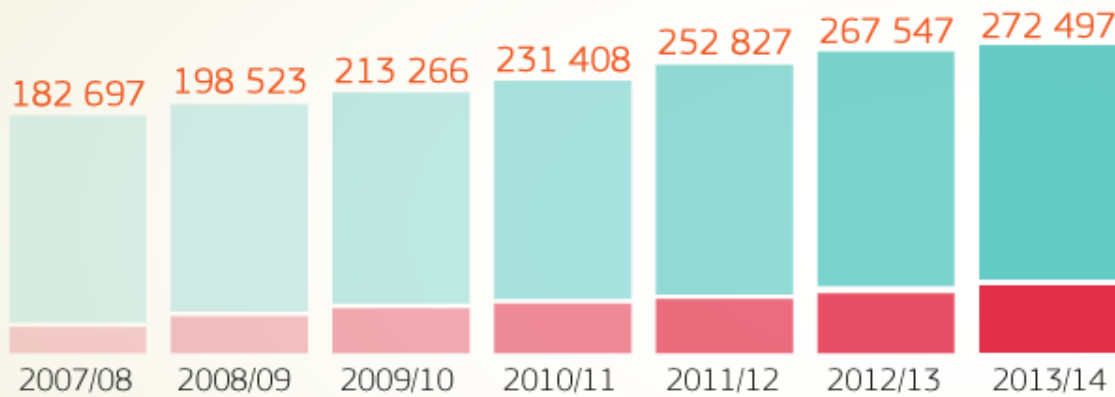

Studies + Traineeships = Total student mobility

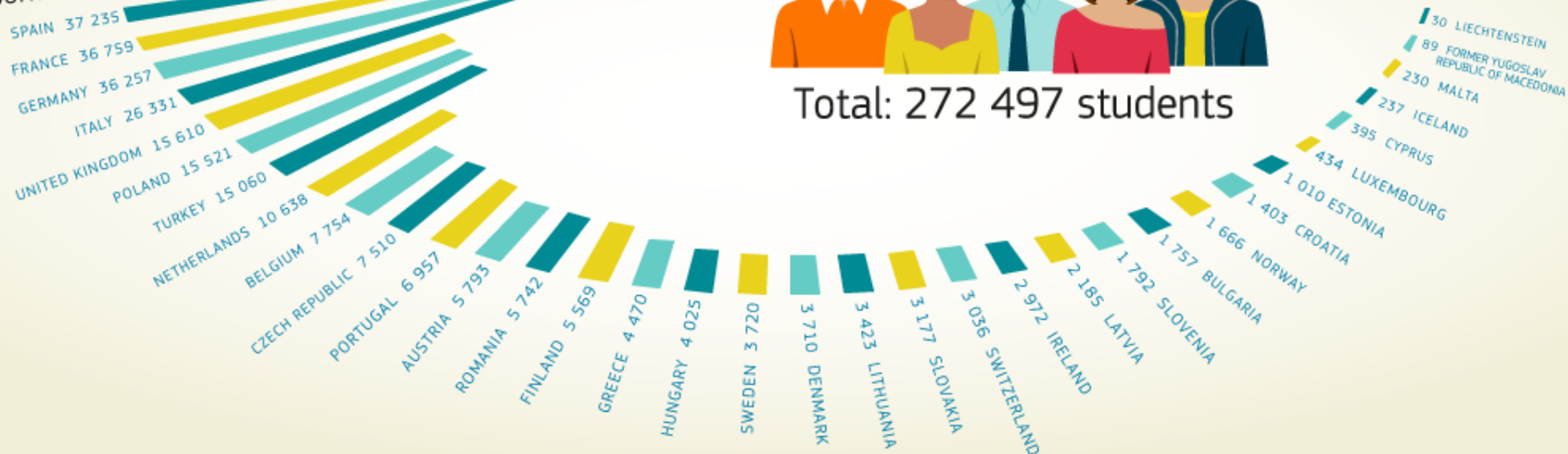


Erasmus students per home country 2013-2014

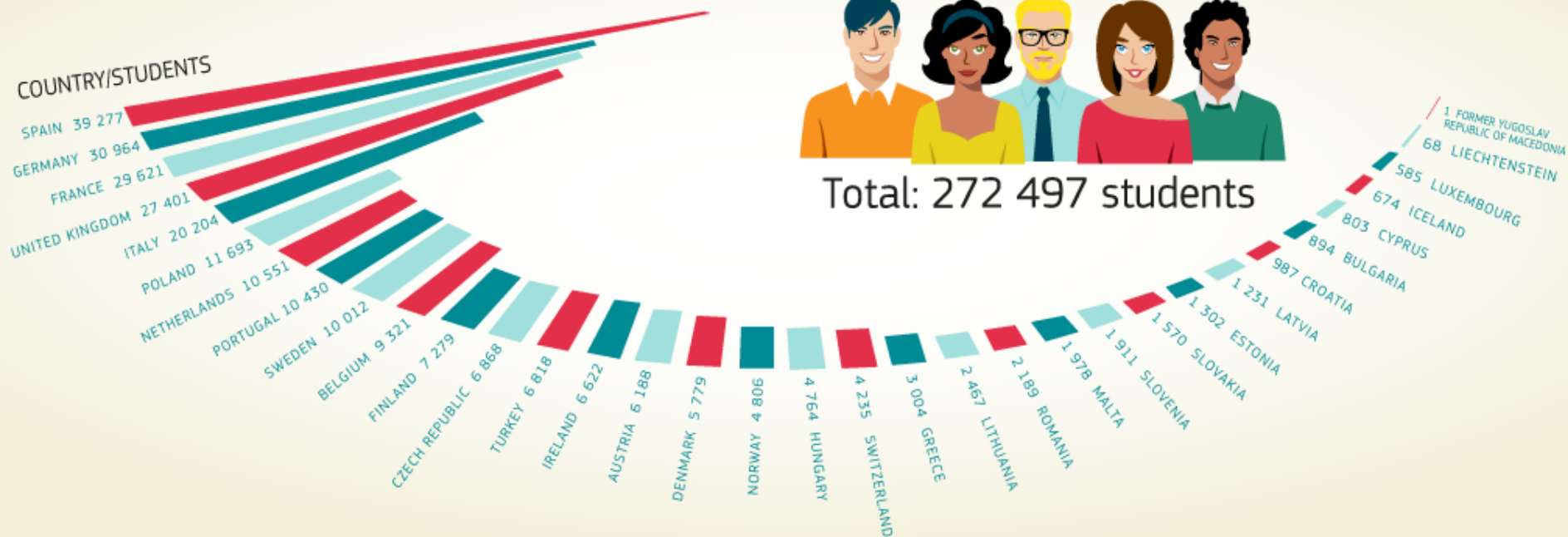

Erasmus most popular destination countries 2013-2014



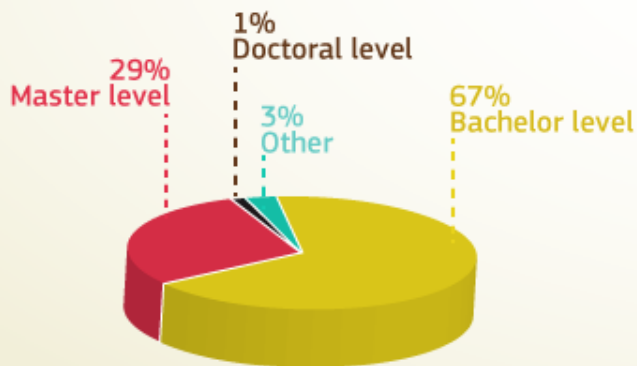
Typical Erasmus student 2013-2014



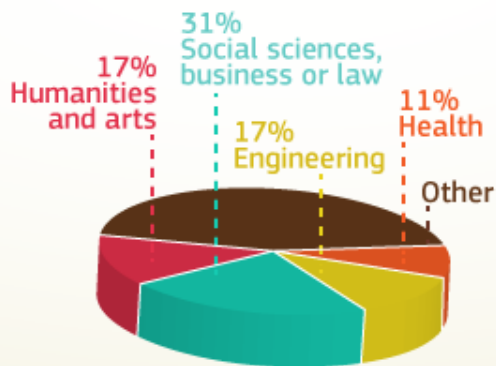

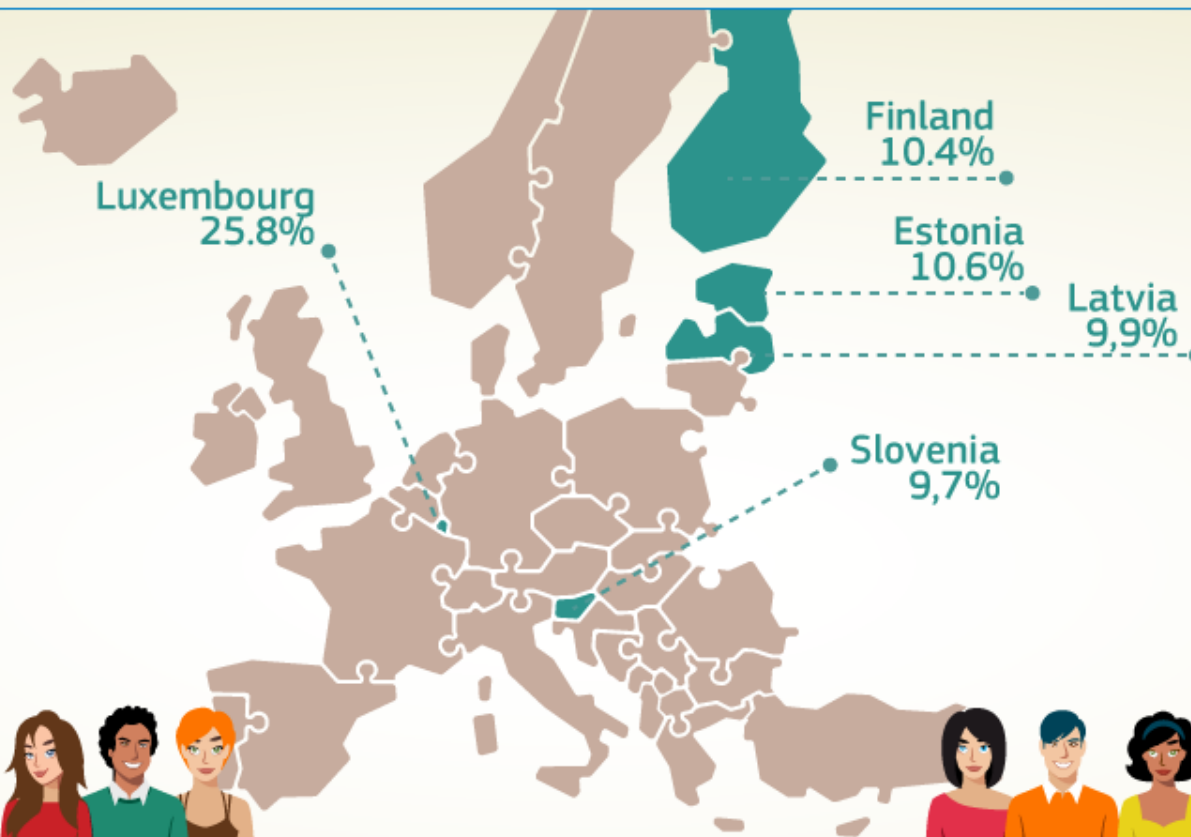

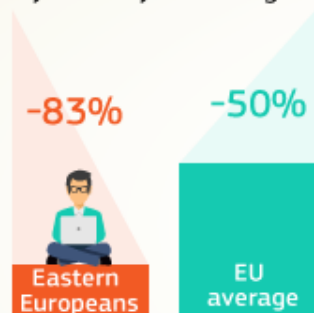

How will Erasmus change your life?



Erasmus alumni are half as likely as non-mobile students to be unemployed one year after graduation



Risk of unemployment 5-10 years after graduation compared to non-mobile students

Southern Europeans: -56%



EU average: -14%



Erasmus trainees offered a position by their host company



EU: 1 in 3 students



Southern Europeans: almost 1 in 2 students



Recruiters who value these skills

Northern Europe: 98%
EU average: 93%
