Mobilities for each educational step

- Pupils mobility at school
- Studying abroad in Higher Education
- Traineeships abroad
- Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees
- Students with physical, mental or health-related conditions

Erasmus+ helps organise student and doctoral candidate exchanges

These take place

- within countries fully part of the Erasmus+ programme
- to and from countries associated to Erasmus+

Why choose to study abroad

- improve your communication, language and inter-cultural skills
- gain soft skills highly valued by employers
- combine with a traineeship abroad to gain work experience



How to apply

There's no central application form to study abroad with Erasmus+

Students can reach out to the international or Erasmus+ office of your university or higher education institution to start the process

The student's sending higher education institution is obliged to select applicants in a fair and transparent way



Who can apply

- students at short-cycle
- Bachelor and Master levels
- Doctoral candidates

The study period abroad must be relevant for the student's degree-related learning and personal development needs and be part of the study programme that you are following

Duration

- **long-term** mobility: minimum of 2 months to a maximum of 12 months abroad (including blended mobilities with a virtual component)
- **short-term** mobility: between 5 and 30 days abroad (these must be blended mobilities)
- **maximum total duration:** 12 months within one study cycle. It is possible to do more than one exchange within that limit.
