Aptis: Practice materials and additional vocabulary



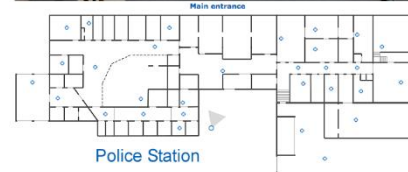

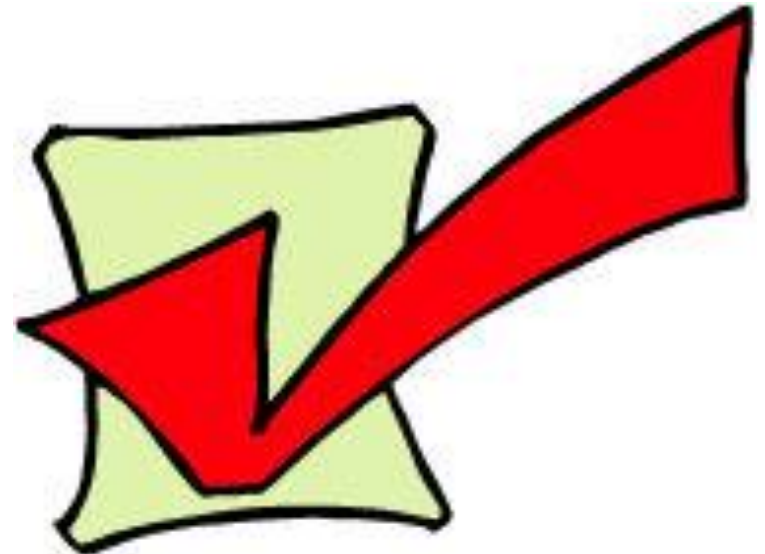
