- 4. Conducting data collection over a defined period, allowing participants sufficient time to respond.
- 5. Secure and anonymous data management with restricted access for the research team.

Results

The findings reveal that students generally see value in using words in sentences to aid retention and self-quizzing for word verification

Acquiring words from movies and television shows and writing them in their note books is viewed positively but with a wider range of responses, highlighting diversity in vocabulary learning approaches among the students.

Conclusions

1. students actively employ vocabulary learning strategies as an integral part of their language learning journey. These strategies are not just a passive aspect of their learning process but are actively utilized with a degree of efficacy that significantly contributes to their reading comprehension skills.

- 2. There are specific strategies favored by students, highlighting the diversity and adaptability of these methods within the student community.
- 3. Encoding, word formation and vocabulary notetaking are the most effective learning strategies employed by the students.
