


Presentations serve as an accepted currency on academic resumes; they influence promotion, career progression, and professional reputation.

Academics are seldom formally trained in public speaking and are expected to develop skills by trial-and-error experience...






Presentations demand of the researcher the ability to communicate in a manner that is resonant, and which conveys significance by connecting with an audience.






While some presentations are compelling, too many are unengaging, or do scant justice to the quality of the material being presented and the talents of the researchers involved.


