Introduction: EFL Speaking Challenges

The Problem

Ecuadorian university students struggle with fluency, improvisation, and communicative sub-skills despite meeting course requirements. Traditional approaches often create anxiety and limit authentic communication opportunities.



Key Issues

Memorized dialogues, unstructured presentations, and lack of spontaneity in real communication contexts



Innovative Solution

PechaKucha format: 20 slides × 20 seconds each, promoting concise, clear communication with visual support

Cognitive Framework

Dual coding theory and multimedia learning principles support visual-verbal integration for enhanced comprehension and retention



Visual Scaffolding

Images provide memory triggers and organizational scaffolds, reducing cognitive overload



Task-Based Learning

Authentic communicative tasks with clear goals and outcomes

Studies show improved fluency, coherence, and confidence in visualsupported presentations

Real-World Application



Pedagogical Advantages

Concision & Clarity

Strict timing compels prioritization of key messages, addressing excessive detail issues in learner presentations



Visual Emphasis

Aligns with multimedia learning principles, reducing cognitive overload while reinforcing comprehension

Learner Autonomy

Topic ownership and product design foster engagement, encouraging English as expression tool rather than academic requirement

Implementation Recommendations

Document Process

Maintain systematic records of observations, reflections, and feedback for ongoing analysis

X Refine Scaffolding

Provide targeted support in discourse markers, transitions, and vocabulary expansion

Promote Visual Literacy

Train students in meaningful image selection and interpretation for effective visual communication

Encourage Reflection

Incorporate journals and peer discussions to develop metacognitive awareness

Plan Longitudinal Evaluation

Follow up to assess skill transfer to academic and professional contexts
