

Longitudinal study (2022–2025) with 494 secondary school teachers




Explores pedagogical values, innovation, and early reactions to AI



Student-centered vs. teachercentered beliefs drive tech use


Mindset > technology access in shaping impact

#### Research Design

- Longitudinal surveys (2022–2025)
- 494 Italian secondary school teachers, diverse subjects
- Data collected during professional development events
- Balanced mix of early-career and veteran educators

#### Student-Centered Pedagogy





Traditional methods (e.g., frontal lessons) rated lowest


Technology = supportive tool, not the core of teaching

# Traits of an Innovative Educator

- Creativity, reflection, resilience, problem-finding
- Top aspiration: creativity (chosen by 35%)
- Teachers want to move from ideals → practice
- Shift toward future-focused, collaborative skills




# Teachers & AI (2025Findings)



• 50%: Al as an opportunity

# Teachers & Al (2025 Findings)

- 44%: cautious openness as main attitude
- Concerns: bias, misinformation, ethics, loss of human contact
- Balance between curiosity and responsibility

Innovative mindset predicts readiness for Al


Teachers value reflection, empathy, problem-solving over novelty
