Consistency with Europe 2020 policies and ET2020 strategic Framework



The eligible type of organizations include:

- Higher education institutions
- Schools
- Adult Education Institutions
- VET* Organizations



The eligible countries are:

- Programme countries
 - The 28 EU member states
 - EEA countries: Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway
 - Candidate Countries (i.e. Turkey, FYROM).
- Partner countries
 - Neighbourg Countries (i.e. Eastern countries, Southern Mediterranean countries, Western Balkans, Russia)
 - All other countries in the world







The total budget for the period 2014-2020 is **14.7 billion euros**


Breakdown of budget by sectors

Minimum allocation by sector

Funded activities in the field of Higher Education

- Students: A study period (3 12 months) or a Placement abroad (2 – 12 months)
- **Staff**: a teaching period in a HEI abroad or participation in a training event abroad

NB The sending organization must be a HEI awarded with an ECHE (<u>Erasmus</u> <u>Charter for Higher Education</u>)





- HEI: 350 euro per participant for organizational support
- STUDENTS: Between 150 to 500 euro per MONTH
- STAFF: Between 50 to 160 euro per DAY
- Between 180 to 1100 euro per travel





Participants

At least one sending and one receiving organizations must be involved

Duration	Deadline
16 to 24 months.	Beginning of February every year

KA 2 Cooperation is divided into 4 actions

- **1 Knowledge Alliances**
- 2 Capacity Building
- **3- Strategic Partnerships**
- 4 Sector Skills Alliances

KA 2 – Knowledge Alliances





Knowledge Alliances projects aim to:

- Promote innovation
- Promote entrepreneurship
- Promote cooperation between HE and enterprises

Key features of Knowledge Alliances are: Innovation; Sustainability; Impact.



Participants

Minimum 6 organisations from three countries, out of which at least two **HE institutions** and at **least two enterprises**.

Duration	Deadline
2 or 3 years.	End of February every year

Where to submit the Grant request EACEA

Funding 700.000 Euro (2 years projects) 1.000.000 Euro (3 years projects)

KA 2 – Capacity Building







Capacity Building projects aim to foster **innovation and internationalisation** HEI in the eligible <u>Partner</u> Countries according to the following priorities:

- **1) Modernization of Curricula** by developing innovative methodologies.
- 2) Improving management, innovation and internationalisation in HE
- 3) Developing **the HE sector within the society** at large and supporting reform policies





For every «Region» specific priorities are identified

- 1) Western Balkans (Albania, Bosnia, Serbia, Montenegro, Kosovo)
- 2) Eastrn Countries (Armenia, Georgia, Belarus etc.)
- 3) South Mediterranean Countries (Egypt, Morocco, Jordan, Lebanon etc)
- 4) Russia
- 5) Asia (Afghaistan, China, Cambodia, Malaysia, Vietnam etc.)
- 6) Central Asia (Kazakstan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan etc.)
- 7) Latin America (Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Venezuela etc.)
- 8) Gulf Countries (Iran, Iraq, Yemen)
- 9) South Africa
- 10) ACP Countries (African, Caribbean and Pacific Group of States)



Partner countries can participate both as project partner or as project applicants

At least 6 HEI

- 3 in the Partner country
- 3 from three different Programme countries



Duration 2 or 3 years.

Deadline Beginning of February every year

Funding

500.000 Euro (2 years projects) 1.000.000 Euro (3 years projects)

KA 2 – Strategic Partnership
