

## Jitka Kazelleová

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Jitka Kazelleová graduated in Foreign Languages (German, English) from Masaryk University in Brno in 1969 where she got her Doctor Degree in German Literature in 1979. From 1969 she was teaching for 5 years at secondary schools, after that she started to work at the Regional In-Service Teacher Training Centre. She organized and taught at many seminars for foreign language teachers. After 1989 she was one of the founders of a new pilot centre for In-Service Teacher Training. Since 2005 she has been involved in Lifelong Learning Programme for teachers, heads of schools and inspectors at the Faculty of Education, Masaryk University Brno. She is an expert in planning and management of projects focusing on the areas of school management, foreign language training and methodology.

She has experience from many international projects where she worked as a coordinator for the Czech Republic, e.g. TEMPUS - Developing Schools for Democracy, PHARE - Programme for Czech School Inspection, PHARE - Training Programme in Modern School Management; Curriculum Development; Moderatoren Ausbildung in Schulmanagement; Training Programme in Modern Languages, LEONARDO - Handlungsorientiertes Ausbildungsprogramm fuer DaF im Beruf auf Fachschulniveau; A Comparison of Evaluation of Vocational Education, THENUCE – THEG 7 – Networking of Universities, Grundtvig PAVE - Promoting Audio-Visual Resources in Adult Education etc. Her experience from international cooperation was published for example in Handlungsorientiertes Ausbildungsprogramm fuer Berufsschulen, CDVU 2001 or in Developing Schools for Democracy in Europe in Oxford Studies in Comparative Education, 1995.

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
