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Currently Ildiko Szogedi works as Project Coordinator for several European projects at the National Institute for Quality and Organizational Development in Healthcare and Medicines (GYEMSZI-ETI) in Budapest. Beforehand she worked at the University of Pécs, Faculty of Health Sciences Training Center, at the Nursing Department as a Senior Lecturer. After acquiring her Bachelor's degree as a Nursing Teacher (1981), Ildiko earned a Master's degree as a Curriculum Developer, School Analyst and Pedagogy Teacher (1997).

Since 2008 Ildiko has been a Ph.D. student at the University of Pécs Health Sciences Ph.D. school, working on her thesis in PBL (Problem Based Learning) which is a new practical method of skill development in the field of health sciences in the higher education.
