Richard Rossner is a consultant in the field of education, specifically educational management and language education. Until June 2011 he was Executive Director of EAQUALS, an international association of schools and institutions committed to providing high quality foreign language education, of which he was a co-founder. He continues to represent EAQUALS on various EU projects, and is an EAQUALS inspector/auditor.

Richard qualified as a teacher of German and French at Oxford but was mainly involved in English language teaching from 1967 until 2005. After 10 years in Mexico as teacher, teacher trainer and manager, he was appointed editor of ELT Journal (1980-1986). In 1984, he joined Bell International as a school manager, then as a senior manager. He was Chief Executive of the Bell Educational Trust from 1998 to 2005.

Richard Rossner is currently a member of a Council of Europe co-ordinating group, an EAQUALS inspector and involved in several EU projects on behalf of EAQUALS, including the NELLIP project and the EPG project. He also represents the UK on the ISO technical committee for educational services, which has recently developed a standard, ISO 29990, for providers of learning services in education and training, and is preparing a subsidiary one for language learning services. He is author and co-author of numerous textbooks and articles on language teaching and language teacher training.
