His main research topics are semantics, corpus linguistic, language acquisition theory. Massimo Moneglia is author of more than 120 contributions in the above fields.

Massimo Moneglia has a long experience in multimedia formats for the representation of linguistic information in speech resources in various non-standard contexts such as Spontaneous speech, Language acquisition, language pathology.

He organised the spoken language archive of the LABLITA lab and co-ordinated the LABLITA Unit in various ITC EU project (C-ORAL-ROM AXMEDIS, INTERA).

Massimo Moneglia currently coordinates the RIDIRE project in the FIRB program of the Italian Ministry of Research and the IMAGACT project in the PAR/FAS program of the Tuscan Region.

In the field of Natural Language Semantics he developed a theoretical framework for the representation of the lexical knowledge which gave rise to the IMAGACT project.
