

Valerio Luigi Alberizzi holds a Ph.D. in Japanese Language and Linguistics from the University of Ca' Foscari, Venice (Italy).

He is currently Associate Professor at the Open Education Center, Waseda University, Tōkyō, where he coordinates the Italian language program. He also teaches contrastive linguistics at Shirayuri College, Tōkyō, and Italian language at Bunkyo Gakuin University and at Nichii kyōkai (The Italian-Japanese Association).

He has taught courses on both modern and classical Japanese language in the Department of East Asian Studies, University of Ca' Foscari, Venice, and in the Department of Modern Foreign Languages and Literatures at the Alma Mater Studiorum University of Bologna.

At Venice University he was also the supervisor of the e-learning project for East Asian Languages, where used a Moodle-based platform to develop various Japanese language courses in collaboration with his students.

His interests range from the history of the Japanese language, especially the evolution of written hybrid styles, to foreign-language teaching using new technologies.

He is also an experienced interpreter and a translator of books and subtitles for movies that were screened at such renowned film festivals as Venice and Berlin.
