

# From our territory to Europe: acquiring new skills

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### Module title:

# "People migration flows in the Taro, Ceno, Parma Valleys".

Fornovo: 2 first form classes involved (41 students, 13 teachers divided into 4 branches of learning). Langhirano: 1 first form class involved (20 students, 4 teachers).

# Aims of the Project:

- Promoting planning and experimentation of educational experiences based on skills;
- Encouraging team teaching and evaluation centred on skills;
- Promoting evaluation through tests based on the OCSE-PISA model;
- Sharing educational tools and didactic materials produced in schools.

### **Teaching Methods:**

Team work and shared planning by all class teachers on a common theme; educational workshops; learning by doing; group work; use of information technology.

A questionnaire entitled "Migration flows in the Taro, Ceno and Parma Valleys in the last 10 years" was drawn up, administered and the data processed.

Each department dealt with different aspects:

MATHEMATICS: Data processing.

LANGUAGES: Italian : <u>Places and cultures;</u>

English : <u>A trip into the world;</u>

#### <u>Migration</u>.

HISTORY & SOCIAL STUDIES : Local history, lines of communication

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY : Geomorphology and land resources.
