



Aims of the CLC project





Creativity & Innovation

Entrepreneurship

- is more than simply starting a business
- Individuals identify opportunities, allocate resources and create value.
- It involves risk-taking, skills such as pro-activity, determination, leadership, creativity, risk-taking and initiative.

Initiative

 the ability to plan lead and manage projects (and to mobilise people, networks and resources) in order to achieve an objective.

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Skills Toolbox



Creativity & Innovation

- Creativity capability to produce something new, new solutions, new methods or devices a richness of ideas and originality of thinking (Britannica Concise Encyclopaedia).
- Innovation means translating ideas into new products and processes, taking novelty, create value, improve products, systems or practices.
- Risk Taking is undertaken with the expectation of positive outcome that will outweigh any implied risks.
