Margareta Simona IVAN is Director of the Qualifications Department within the National Qualifications Authority of Romania.

She graduated in History from the University of Bucharest, then a Master Business Management programme of the University Paris XII Val de Marne in France in 1993. She has a significant career in the field of education and training, involving both teaching activities in the fields of History, Marketing, Project Cycle Management and participation in the design and development of the national qualifications framework, as well as in the implementation of national and European projects involving a multicultural environment and international teams.

While her career in the past 15 years has focused mainly on the higher education field, and she played an important role in the development of the Romanian qualifications framework for higher education and of the self-certification report, in the past two years her activities encompassed the adult training field as well.
