Lisa Gjedde is Associate Professor in Media, ICT and Learning at the Dept for Learning and Philosophy Aalborg University in Copenhagen, Denmark.

She holds a Ph.d. in narrative and cognition from Roskilde University, from the department of Communication, Education and Information Science in 2000.

Dr. Gjedde's research has been focused on designing and researching technology enhanced learning environments for creative and imaginative learning for a wide range of target groups, using visual and productive approaches like animation production, as a tool for learning.

Her research has for several years been aimed at exploring the learning potentials of story-based learning environments and narrative artifacts, and how the use of narrative may lead to inclusive, engaging and imaginative learning. She is also investigating designs for learning with multimodal approaches.

In relation to this she has developed processual methodologies to research the learning potentials and experiences of the users, and done research on user experiences in interactive environments.

She has been principal investigator on a large number of projects funded by the Danish Ministry of Education and other public and private Danish and European agencies, and has published several papers, book-chapters and two co-authored books.

Dr. Gjedde is a member of several Scientific Programme Committees, is a member of the LEAF Nordic research network and is on the board of directors of FLUID, the Danish Society for Flexible ICT-based Learning.
