George K. Mikros is currently Associate Professor of Computational and Quantitative Linguistics in the Department of Italian Language and Literature in the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens.

He graduated from the Department of Italian Language and Literature (Aristotle University of Thessaloniki) in 1992. He completed his Ph.D. thesis in 1999 at the Department of Linguistics (National and Kapodistrian University of Athens). In 1992 he joined Institute for Language and Speech Processing (ILSP) and in 1996-1998 he was head of the Institute's Liaison Office. Since 1999 coordinates the Course Unit ISP12 "Understanding the Language and Civilization: From Latin to Modern Spanish" in the undergraduate program "Hispanic Language and Civilisation Studies" at the Hellenic Open University.

He has participated in many European and National Research Programs in the area of Human Language Technology. He was elected Member at Large of the International Association of Quantitative Linguistics (IQLA) (2007-2009) and program member in many International Conferences in the area of Computational Linguistics.

Publishes in international journals and peer-reviewed conference proceedings in the following areas: Computational Linguistics, Corpus Linguistics, Quantitative Linguistic Data Analysis, Computer Assisted Language Learning, Stylometry, Automatic Authorship Attribution, Opinion Mining and Sentiment Analysis.
